This cost estimate is to conduct a Class III survey of approximately 1000 acres as shown on the map in your January 20, 1990 letter. As part of the project we will notify the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) of our intent to conduct a cultural resource survey, conduct a literature search at the BLM, survey the entire parcel on foot in adjacent sweeps spaced according to BLM guidelines, locate, record, map and photograph all cultural resource sites, assess all sites for eligibility to the National Register of Historic Places, hand excavate test probes as needed to determine National Register eligibility, prepare a draft report for submission to the BLM, revise the draft report and submit three copies of the final report with recommendations to the BLM, and curate any collected artifacts at the Nevada State Museum. This estimate assumes that the work can be conducted at one time without repeated trips to the project area and does not include extensive down time due to bad weather (such as ground being covered with snow). This bid also includes the cost of any historic archival research necessary to complete the report.
