
Dear Mac,

I presented the Lincoln, the Silver King and the Rowley to my freind at Plexus Resources, the small Canadian company based here in Salt Lake. They are still looking at the Silver King with a sharp pencil as a small shipping operation to one of the Arizona smelters. They don't thin k that either the Lincoln or the Rowley would be economical to work under foreseeable conditions. Right now they have a breccia pipe in Washington that runs about 2 3/4 million tons at 1.8% copper and think it would make an ideal low-cost mining operation but needs \$1.25 to \$1.50 copper to operate. The Rowley is lower grade and would be a higher cost mining operation so they aren't interested.

I am taking the liberty of keeping a copy of your one page summary and the location map and geology map with drill holes plotted in case I have an opportunity to sound out someone else who might be interested. Thanks very much for sending the material to me and maybe something will work out if copper mining ever gets back on its' feet.
