GEOLOGY: Narrow band of metasediments in contact with granodiorite. Sediments
have survived in part because they have been silicified forming a
thin veneer of tactite against the granite. The remaining contact
zone has been eroded. There is considerable schist, and phyllite as
float but not much in outcrop
Sample 2926 was collected from the contact zone and the dump. The
sample lapped well with good highgrade tungsten and some powellite.
The problem with this effort as a mine would be to develop sufficient
ore reserves..it looks to be fairly high grade but the tactite zone
is very narrow.
